Pre-requisite programmes (PRPs) are the minimum control measures, actions and procedures that must be performed to manufacture a product that meets these needs. When implementing PRPs it is important that everybody understands the elements of the pre-requisite programme.

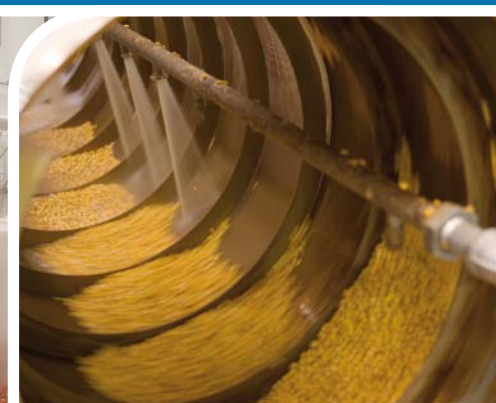


Course Objectives
